## ~ The Parent's Program ~

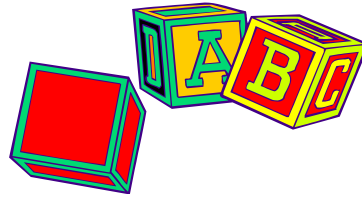
- ☺ To become more understanding of the child's world.
